A Mod Agreement was signed and work is underway to mitigate these mining activities.

Zaid Khan is the PM for Transgrid.

The 330kV Avon to Macarthur Transmission Line (TL17) crosses directly above Customer's existing Longwalls 6 to 8, and the not yet extracted Longwall 19 in Area 3A.

Transgrid has previously completed a feasibility study to assess impact on the transmission line assets, including towers Tower 14 and Tower 15 of 330kV single circuit transmission line TL17.

Following the Feasibility Report a Scoping Study was conducted which provided a detailed assessment to best meet the requirements of both Transgrid and the Customer.

A Modification Agreement was executed to undertake Works to mitigate the impact from mine subsidence including strengthening over-utilised members on towers T14 and T15 and install roller blocks on earth wire and conductors, which now mitigates the impact of the mine expansion.
