## LANDOWNER NOTIFICATION - WARATAH SUPER BATTERY - CRITICAL STATE SIGNIFICANT INFRASTRUCTURE APPLICATION (SSI-48492458)

As you are aware, the Energy Corporation of NSW (EnergyCo) has prepared an application for the Waratah Super Battery project within the former Munmorah Power Station at 301 Scenic Drive, Colongra.
