I wish to object to the proposal for the following reasons.

As a resident of the Jervis Bay area for the past 74 years I have been able to observe the gradual decline in the quality of the bay and beaches due to various inapropate activities

Previous attempts at similar projects disintegrated during the north east gales resulting in debris washed up on the beaches e/g rotting ropes encrusted with dead marine live (which were never cleaned up)

Jervis Bay has a major tourist marine industry operating from Huskisson and surrounding areares which includes diving, whale, and dolphin watch tours any restrictions on where they could operate would be counter productive.

Vincentia sailing club has been established for the past thirty years and hosts major sailing events such as the state and national Hobie cat titles. In February 2014 the world titles will be held on Jervis Bay.

Major events such as this attract participants and their families from all over the world; all available accommodation in the area has been booked out months in advance. As can be seen the additional income to the business community e/g shops, restaurants etc. are considerable.

Any restrictions to access, or obstacles such buoys to the sailing areares used by the various sailing clubs at Jervis Bay should not be considered. Non-polluting activities on the bay should receive your department's full support.
