

**Determination under clause 7.9(2) of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016***

I, Michael Young, Principal Planning Officer (Transport and Water Assessments), of the Department of Planning and Environment, under clause 7.9(2) of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, determine that the Circular Quay Renewal (SSI-60563459) is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values and therefore a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR) is not required.

Proposed development means:

- replacement of the existing wharves, including Wharf 1, with new accessible wharves
- replacement and widening of the southern promenade
- upgrades to Circular Quay Station, including new escalators and lifts
- replacement of operational facilities, including new staff amenities
- new built form to the east and west of the existing station
- renewal of First Fleet Park
- new and upgraded public amenities including provision for retail uses.

If the proposed development changes so that it is no longer consistent with this description, a further waiver request is required.

If you do not lodge the infrastructure application related to this determination for the proposed development within **two (2) years** of the issue date of this determination, you must either prepare a BDAR or lodge a new request to have the BDAR requirement waived.
