I make the following submission to the Environmental Impact Statement exhibition for the Westconnex M4 East Tunnel Project (SSI 6307):

I am opposed to the construction of the M4 East Tunnel and do not believe that spending \$15.4 billion to achieve a 6 minute travel time saving is justified. The Government has ignored the community by signing contracts to build this road before releasing this EIS, the full business case or obtaining planning approval.

The EIS shows that this unjustified project will irreversibly destroy the heritage values of Haberfield, Australia's oldest garden suburb.

I want the following addressed from the EIS:

- Filter the smoke stacks and relocate away from schools and childcare centres.
- Build a noise wall for properties in Ashfield next to the Parramatta Rd interchange, during and after construction.
- Stop rat-running through Haberfield and Ashfield, by removing the right turn into Waratah St, Haberfield and close Chandos St at Parramatta Rd after construction.
- Offer voluntary acquisitions and WDA-funded dilapidation reports for those properties near construction sites in Northcote, Wolseley, Wattle, Walker, Ramsay, Chandos and Loftus Streets.
- Restrict tunnelling and truck movements to standard construction hours - no 24/7 truck movements.
- Return acquired properties not required after construction to Ashfield Council for community use and public open space.

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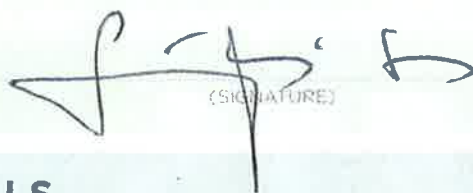

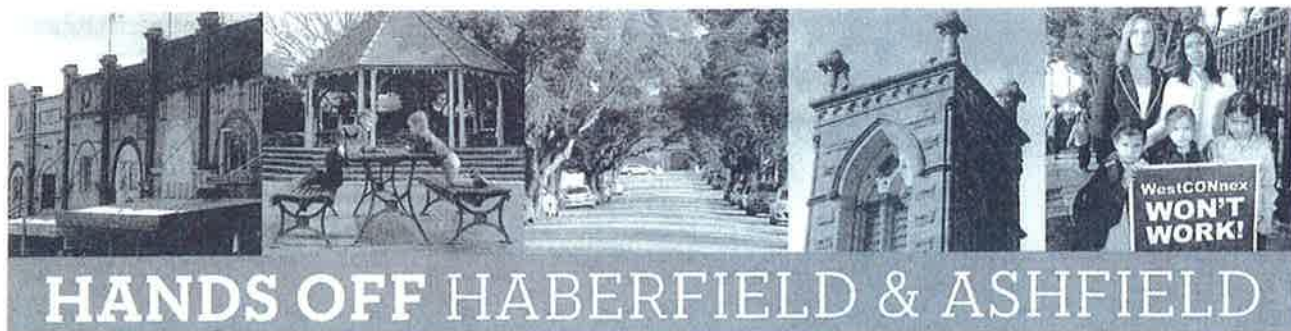

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STRONG OBJECTION TO WESTCONNEX M4

What are the M4 East Project objectives?

A number of objectives were stated each relating to cars and what is oddly termed urban renewal but the last objective caught my attention for its irony.

* Protect natural and cultural resources and enhance the environment.

This statement means nothing if the M4 east destroys natural and cultural resources in Haberfield and other areas.

It is ironic that the WestConnex M4 East project will destroy a large part of Sydney's inner west - heritage suburb of Haberfield. Many homes will be destroyed to make way for the Project's objectives. These homes and this suburb is a significant part of early Australian culture seen through the style of homes, gardens and parks along with the eclectic mix of people who live there. 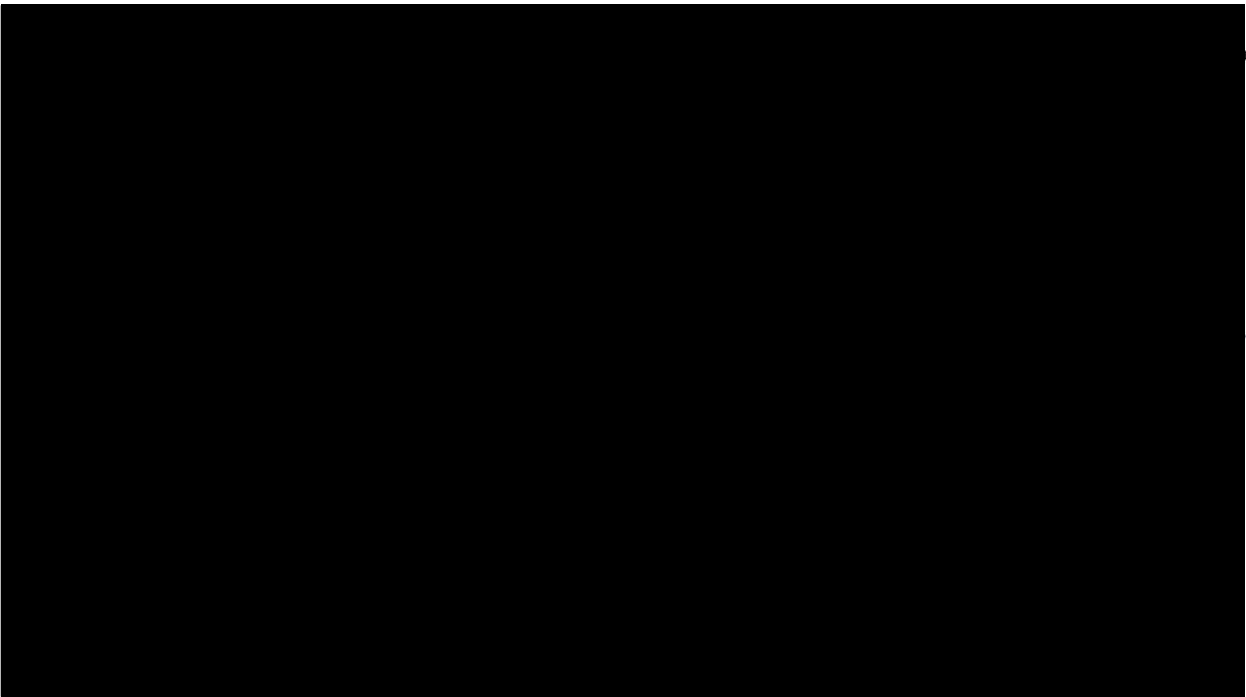
The M4 East (WestConnex) is designed to induce more traffic than currently use our roads. However many roads are at capacity. If the M4 East is tolled it won't be cheap. It stands to reason the traffic on Parramatta Road and other roads will not be reduced as many drivers avoid tolls. It simply follows air quality will not be better.

NOISE AND VIBRATION

From experience the tunnelling process will vibrate structures, in some cases severely (juddering / shaking houses) for at least a kilometre in all directions. I have seen cracks in buildings, fences and roads not to mention damage done to underground structures pipes (water, cable, gas). This is a reality and the NSW government should be prepared to smartly address all claims.

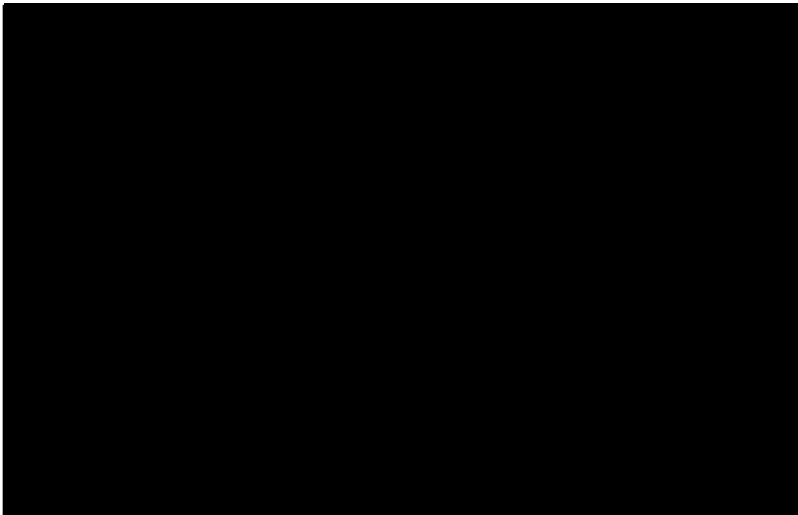

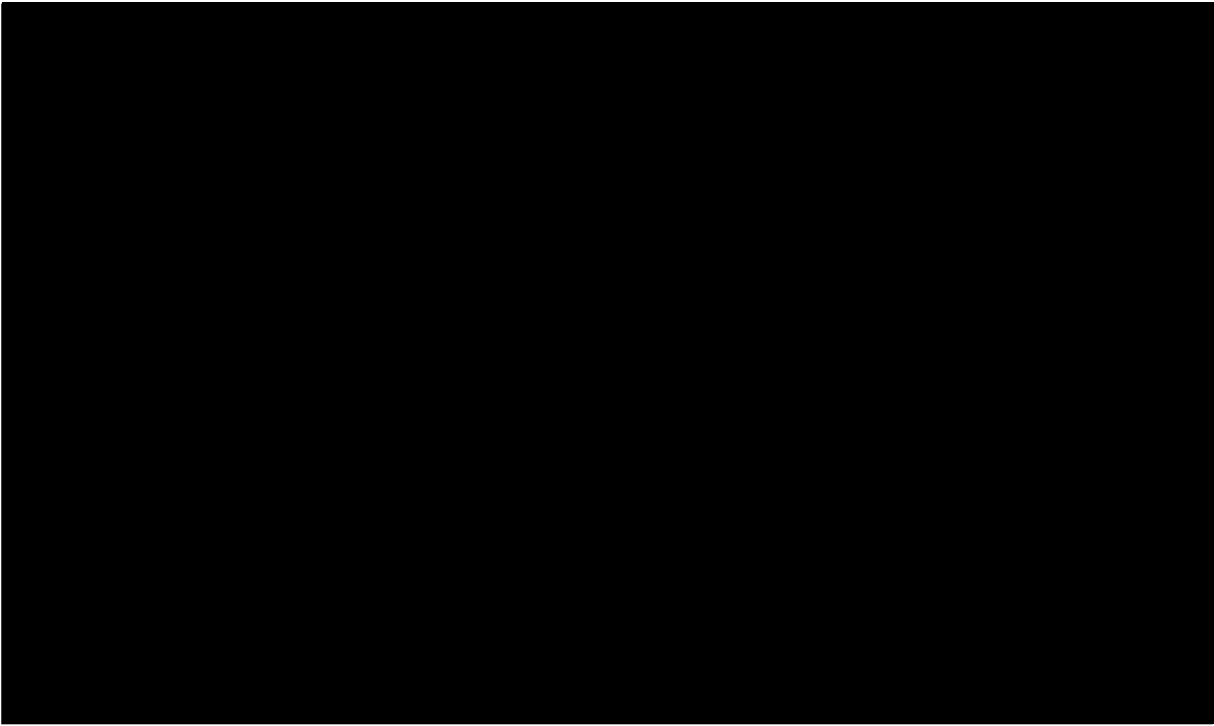
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I object to the planned WestConnex M4 East ('stage 1'). The EIS demonstrates, and independent modelling (per Leichhardt Council) further highlights several traffic issues:

- Traffic too/from the M4 will bottleneck coming into and leaving the tunnel system around Haberfield
- Wattle Street / Dobroyd Parade, being frequently congested will now become overwhelmed with traffic being disgorged via the Wattle St tunnel entry / exit
- Parramatta Road, also heavily congested, will suffer severe congestion at east of the tunnel / entry exits
- 'rat runners' will seek alternatives through residential streets, some of which are already overloaded including Ramsay, Marion, Foster, Flood among others
- The EIS indicates no filter is required for tunnel exhaust stacks. No lesson appears to have been adopted from the M5 east tunnels in this regard.
- The EIS does not properly assess transport alternatives. Whereas building new roads invariably leads to increased traffic, building public transport removes traffic from those streets. I recommend the introduction of several express-train park and ride stations at key points along the M4. Passengers can then travel quickly to the city and the airport in comfort and at lower environmental cost.

The project as proposed brings 19th century thinking to 21st a 21st century city.

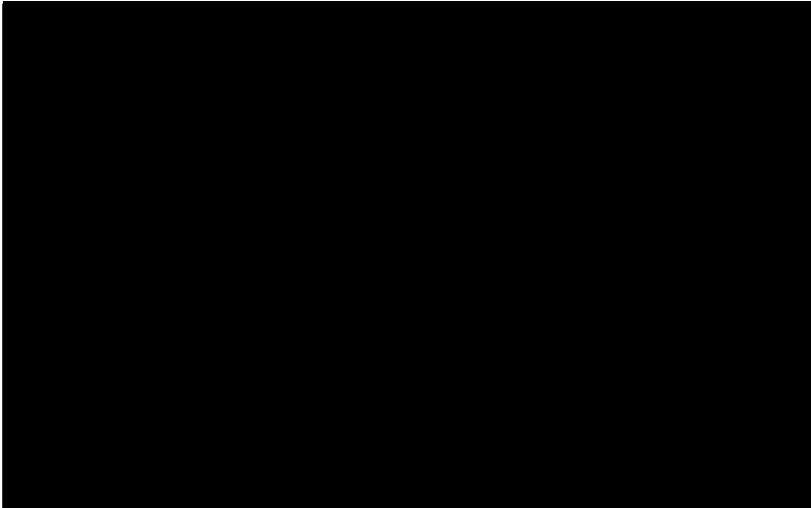

To whom it may concern,

I make the following submission to the Environmental Impact Statement exhibition for the Westconnex M4 East Tunnel Project (SSI 6307):

I am opposed to the construction of the M4 East Tunnel and strongly believe that WestConnex has not been planned with a genuine commitment to transparency and accountability. I believe that spending \$15.4 billion to achieve a 6 minute travel time saving is totally unjustified.

Additionally I believe that the EIS does not evaluates the detrimental impact of the project on other roads through the Haberfield/Leichhardt area, and believe that the traffic congestion will not be reduced on Parramatta Road and this will lead to frustrated drivers "rat-running" through previously quiet local streets in an attempt to avoid the Parramatta Road car park. This "rat-running" in streets such as Chandos St and Rogers Avenue in Haberfield will cause significant safety issues to children attending local schools and Childcare centres on these streets.

The Government has ignored the community by signing contracts to build this road before releasing the EIS, the full business case or obtaining planning approval.

The EIS shows that this unjustified project will irreversibly destroy the heritage values of Haberfield, Australia's oldest garden suburb.

I want the following addressed from the EIS:

- Filter the smoke stacks and relocate away from schools and childcare centres.
- Build a nose wall for properties in Ashfield and Haberfield next to Parramatta Rd interchange, during and after construction.
- Stop rat-running through Haberfield and Ashfield, by removing the right hand turn into Waratah St, Haberfield and close Rogers Avenue and Chandos St at Parramatta Rd during and after construction.
- Offer voluntary acquisitions and WDA-funded dilapidation reports for those properties near construction sites in Northcote, Wolseley, Wattle, Walker, Ramsay, Rogers Avenue, Chandos and Loftus Streets.
- Restrict tunnelling and truck movements to standard construction hours – no 24/7 truck movements.
- return acquired properties not required after construction to Ashfield Council for community use and public open space.

This project will not solve Sydney's traffic problems and NSW taxpayers money is better spent investing in Public Transport. Please consider my concerns and address them in your response to the community's submissions to the EIS.
