Dear Kurtis Wathen,

Thank you for inviting Subsidence Advisory to advise on above project including the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Sections of the proposed project which are located within mine subsidence districts with varying risks associated with mine subsidence. As stated in the EIS, approval will be required from Subsidence Advisory NSW under *section 22 of the Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Act 2017* (the Act) for the project.

Subsidence Advisory have received and are currently assessing an application for the Hunter Transmission Project which (in part) includes construction of a new overhead double circuit 500kV transmission line between Bayswater and Eraring power stations; 2 new switching stations (at Bayswater and Olney); upgrades to existing transmission lines and to the existing Bayswater and Eraring substations; utility adjustments and ancillary works.

A subsidence assessment for the project by MSEC (Mine Subsidence Engineering Consultants) dated July 2025 has been provided with the application and is currently being reviewed.

A determination for the above application currently under assessment will be provided in due course.
