Re: The Northern Road Upgrade (SSI 7127) Condition of Approval (CoA) E19 and E20.

Please find enclosed the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Report that has been prepared in accordance with CoA E19 and E20. This report is provided to the Department for information as required by CoA E20.

The Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Report was submitted to the Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs) for endorsement on the 5 March 2021 for The Northern Road Stage 4 and the 2 July 2021 for The Northern Road Stage 5 & 6. Verbal endorsement from the RAPs has been provided to the consultant and Transport for NSW Aboriginal Engagement team. However written responses from most of the RAPs has not yet been obtained. A communication log has been provided below to highlight TfNSW's attempts to contact the RAPs to obtain written endorsement.

As part of the consultation for the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Report, RAPS and attendees at the Aboriginal Focus Group meetings were asked for suggestions on how to manage the salvaged artefacts. The Deerubbin Local Aboriginal Land Council (Deerubbin LALC) indicated that they would like to keep the artefacts. TfNSW has attempted to arrange for transfer of the artefacts to Deerubin LALC. However, at this stage Kelleher Nightingale Consulting is still the caretaker for the salvaged items.

The Transport for NSW Aboriginal Engagement team will continue to discuss options for the artefacts with Deerubbin LALC. In addition, Transport for NSW will explore alternative options with Heritage NSW. Upon resolution of a permanent storage location for the salvaged artefacts, Transport for NSW will provide an update to the Department.
