## CSSI 7474 Narrabri to North Star, Phase 1 (N2NS) Project Request for an Extension of Time to Submit Amendments to the Ecosystem and Species Credit Requirements and the Report on Final Construction Footprint Minister's Condition of Approval E19 and E24

I refer to the Ministers Conditions of Approval (**MCoA's**) issued for the Critical State Significant Infrastructure (**CSSI**) Project No 7474 Narrabri to North Star, Phase 1 dated 13 August 2020 (**N2NS Planning Approval**), and specifically the requirements for reporting on amendments to the ecosystem and species credit requirements and the final construction footprint demonstrating reduced environmental impacts within six (6) months after the commencement of construction required by MCoA's E19 and E24 respectively.

It is noted that construction of the N2NS Project commenced 10 April 2021.

I also refer to ARTC's correspondence regarding an extension request of this submission date from 10 October 2021 to 10 November 2021 (Ref: 6-0000-260-EEC-00-LT-0036), which was approved by the Department of Planning and Environment (**the Department**) on 11 October 2021 and the subsequent extension request (Ref: 6-0000-260-EEC-00-LT-0052) to the current due submission date of 28 February 2022 which was approved on 24th January 2022.

As the Department are aware, the construction footprint for the N2NS Project was revised and provided to the various agencies for comment on 10 September 2021 in accordance with MCoA E24 and again on the 6 January 2022. One of the key objectives of the construction footprint reduction was to reduce environmental impacts, including impacts to Plant Community Types (**PCTs**), Koala habitat and biodiversity offsets.

ARTC received feedback from EES on the 14 February 2022 requiring clarifications which require the report to be further updated and appropriate responses developed to meet EES expectations. In addition to this, ARTC wishes to review its original assumptions to ensure a practical final footprint is provided so to reduce any further changes (via modification) in the future that may occur due to unforeseen circumstances. The current ongoing engagement with EES and DAWE (note – no comments have been received to date from DAWE) highlights ARTCs overall commitment to the reduction of its Construction Impact Zone, and the optimisation of this footprint scope proposed is a test to ensure that the project has the practical footprint required to complete the scope of works whilst minimising any unnecessary administrative burden.
