I am writing about the operational rail noise level for my property, P2N_Rx0287, which is Aeq 59 (night) which is below the criteria for noise abatement of 60 yet my neighbour at P2N_ Rx0285 has been identified to be considered for noise abatement at Aeq 61. I would like to know why this is so as we are both the same distance from the tracks and will both be equally affected by increased rail activity of both size and frequency with the Inland Rail - Parkes to Narromine project.

I am also writing to voice my concern for the construction period due to begin in 2018. I have been told that work will be carried out from 6am to 6pm Monday to Sunday. Also with the track close to my property, 3 culverts closeby have been identified with potential possession work of 24 hours a day. I am concerned of the noise level of the work being carried out for long periods across the day that will impact upon my family's daily routine as I work fulltime, as does my son who travels daily to work at Dubbo and i have a daughter who attends primary school each day. I am concerned for the noise level and interruption this will cause to us, impacting upon our time at home for sleep, rest and relaxation during the times of day that we are home and not working, especially during the early hours of the morning and if work is to be carried out 24 hours a day.

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
