The event was notified at 4:49pm (EPA reference number EPA-110124) in accordance with Condition R2.1 of Environment Protection Licence 21138 (EPL) and as required under the <i>Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997</i>.</p> <p>The following details were provided to the EPA via the Environment Line service:</p> <p>The pollution event was confirmed at 9am on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2020 by surveyors on site. An estimation of 50m<sup>3</sup> of soil material left the EPL Premise Boundary into a neighbouring property north of Henry Parkes Way Level Crossing. The Landholder has been notified. The Project's EPA Officer (based in Dubbo) had also been notified.</p>
