I refer to your submission dated 16 November 2022, requesting approval of the revised Coffs Harbour Bypass Community Communications Strategy (Revision 4, November 2022).

I note that revisions have been made to the Community Communications Strategy since it was previously approved (Revision 2, 14 December 2022). These revisions have been made to reflect the progress of the project towards commencement of construction and they do not substantially change the intent of the document. I also note advice received from Transport for NSW that Revision 3 was produced in error, and all changes made since Revision 2 have been captured in the tracked changes version of Revision 4 provided to the Department.
