**Western Harbour Tunnel and Waringah Freeway Upgrade (SSI 8863)  
Local Road Request**

I refer to the document titled 'CoA E132 – Local Roads Approval' submitted to the Department on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2021 in accordance with Conditions E133 and E132 of the Western Harbour Tunnel and Waringah Freeway Upgrade (SSI 8863).

I note:

- Mr. Phillip Truong a project manager and traffic and transport engineer / planner with over 12 years of experience has provided advice that the proposed usage of local roads meet the conditions of approval,
- a swept path analysis was conducted for all local roads which shows 12.5 m rigid heavy vehicles can appropriately navigate the roads,
- you advise consultation with the ANZAC Park Public School and North Sydney Council regarding the use of local roads has occurred,
- Transport for NSW has reviewed the request and has raised no concerns, and
- You will implement suitable measures to manage the potential road user and pedestrian impacts and these will be implemented for the duration of the works.

Accordingly, as a nominee of the Planning Secretary I approved the use of local roads as detailed in Table 1 (attached) for a period of 12 months from the date of this letter. Please ensure that North Sydney Council, ANZAC Park Public School and Bicycle NSW are informed of the approved local road usage and the measures in place to minimise impacts.

You are reminded that the use of Local Roads outside of standard construction hours is not permitted until the construction environmental management plan is approved.
