Subject: Warringah Freeway Upgrade – Stage 2 (SSI-8863): Construction Parking and Access Strategy (CPAS), South Zone

Dear Mr Sheppard,

I refer to the updated Warringah Freeway Upgrade (WFU) Stage 2 Construction Parking and Access Strategy (CPAS): South Zone (revision 9, dated 27 June 2025), submitted to the Planning Secretary for approval under condition E140 of SSI-8863. I also acknowledge your response to the Department's review comments and request for additional information.

I note the updated CPAS South Zone, revision 9:

- includes the extension of temporary parking removals on:
 - High Street East Precinct (McDougall Street) until 31 July 2025,
 - Ridge Street Precinct (Ridge Street East) until 31 December 2025, and
 - Falcon-Miller Street Precinct (Miller Street) until 31 December 2025.
- continues to include construction parking mitigation measures approved in CPAS revision 8 to mitigate the loss of on-street parking; and
- has been prepared in consultation with affected stakeholders including North Sydney Council, James Milson Retirement Village and the local community; and
- has been reviewed by Transport for NSW and no issues have been raised with the Department.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the WFU Stage 2 Construction Parking and Access Strategy: South Zone (Revision 9, dated 27 June 2025) under condition E140 of SSI-8863.

Please ensure that the approved plan is placed on the project website in accordance with condition B15.

I remind you of your commitments to continue to consult with North Sydney Council and the affected local community, and that you manage any unforeseen parking impacts in accordance with the mitigation measures outlined in the CPAS.

You are reminded that if there are any inconsistencies between the approved CPAS and the conditions of approval, the conditions prevail.
