**Western Harbour Tunnel and Warringah Freeway Upgrade Stage 2 (SSI-8863)
Local Roads Approval (Condition E132)**

I refer to the Local Roads Approval Revision D, dated 17 May 2022, submitted to the Planning Secretary for approval in accordance with condition E132 for Stage 2 of SSI-8863. I also acknowledge and thank you for your responses to the Department's review comments and requests for additional information.

I note that the Local Roads Approval Revision D:

- includes proposed heavy vehicle use of Amherst Street (between Warringah Rd and Miller St), Cammeray Road (between Park Ave and Amherst St) and Park Avenue (between Ernest St and Cammeray Rd), Cammeray;
- describes how traffic impacts will be managed during the Project's Cammeray Golf Course/Ernest Street Site Establishment phase of construction;
- was endorsed by a suitably qualified traffic engineer Mr Denis Fung from CPB Downer; and
- has been reviewed by Transport for NSW and no issues were raised.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Local Roads Approval Revision D, dated 17 May 2022. Please ensure that the approved plan is placed on the project website in accordance with condition B15.

I remind you of your commitment to manage heavy vehicle volumes and movements while local road use is being shared across both Stage 1A Early Works and Stage 2 works.

These local roads are approved for use for 12 months from the date of this letter. Further extensions to the use of these roads will require the Department's review and approval.

As per condition E132, the Traffic, Transport and Access Management Sub-Plan is required to be updated following this approval. Please ensure that North Sydney Council, ANZAC Park Public School, Bike North and Bike NSW are informed of the approved local road usage and the measures in place to minimise impacts for the duration of the works.
