F6 Extension Stage 1 New M5 Arncliffe to President Avenue, Kogarah **Application number SSI 8931**

I refer to the State Significant Infrastructure Application No. SSI 17 8931 for F6 Extension Stage 1 New M5 Arnciliffe to President Avenue, Kogarah on public exhibition between 7 November 2018 and 14 December 2018.

Council is writing to seek an extension to the public exhibition period by 90 days in order to make a submission on the proposed development as:

- 1. Council records indicate that Georges River Council has not formally received notification of the application, notwithstanding the potential impacts on residents within the LGA. To make an informed submission Council's technical officers will be required to review the extensive set of documentation submitted.
- 2. Given the time of year and extent of documentation, community members and resident groups may have difficulty making submissions in the limited period provided.
- 3. Further discussion with the elected Councillors is still required.

- Environmental implications of the project
- Inadequate detail associated with public transport and demandmanagement initiatives that could achieve similar congestion reductions and so equivalent travel time savings through reduced congestion
- Impact associated with changes to above ground traffic management
- Inadequate detail associated with the impact of the proposal on the long term viability of Sydney's public transport and active transport network
- Environmental Impact (onsite vegetation, tree removal, site contamination etc.)
- Air quality and health impacts
- Location and implementation of ventilation stacks
- Design and location of the proposed complexes to manage and operate the motorway
- Construction Management
- Resident concerns / stake holder consultation and management
