**M6S1 Stage 2 (SSI-8931)**

**Request to install at-property treatments in parallel with commencement of out-of-hours works (E78)**

I refer to your letter dated 25 November 2021, requesting to install at-property treatments in parallel with the commencement of out-of-hours works (OOHW) in accordance with condition E78 of SSI 8863. I acknowledge and thank you for your responses to the Department's request for additional information.

I understand that the COVID-19 restrictions during 2021 have significantly impacted on the Project's planning, procurement and delivery of at-property noise treatments prior to OOHW commencing. I note that the project is now making progress with 153 properties out of 274 accepting offers, however treatment has not yet been finalised. You have indicated that a significant number of properties will be impacted by noise from out-of-hours works from January 2022 when construction begins.

I note that condition E78 requires at-property construction noise mitigation treatments to be installed prior to the commencement of any OOHW that may cause sleep disturbance unless otherwise approved by the Planning Secretary.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve your request to install at property treatments in parallel with the commencement of out of hours works subject to the following information being provided to the Department **weekly**:

- a table including the property addresses, stage of noise treatment delivery (including dates), timing of works and type of works impacting the property;
- an up-to-date schedule of works for the project;
- evidence of consultation regarding OOHW, including a list of properties and recipients it was sent to and any feedback received and how it was addressed;
- a table of complaints received including the property address and how it was responded to; and
- a table of respite offers including the property address and what was offered.

I also note that you are required to demonstrate that appropriate mitigation measures are being effectively implemented, the community is being appropriately informed and consulted and complaints are being responded to.
