Inland Rail – Illabo to Stockinbingal (SSI-9406) – approval of Public Level Crossing Treatment Report (Phase 1) under condition E88

Dear Ian,

I refer to your submission, received by the Department on 10 July 2026, of the Inland Rail Illabo to Stockinbingal Public Level Crossing Treatment Report (Phase 1) (IRPL Document No. 5-0019-220-CXR-00-RP-0002 revision 2 dated 22 July 2026) required under condition E88 (the Document).

I note the Document:

- addresses the Phase 1 public level crossings at Ironbong Road (PU8160), Corby's Lane (PU33780) and Paper Road (PU11390);
- was prepared in consultation with Transport for NSW, Junee Shire Council, Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council and Crown Lands, including through workshops, design reviews and correspondence; and
- documents that the Phase 2 public level crossings at Old Sydney Road (PU5600) and Unnamed Council Road (PU15950) are separate from the Phase 1 crossings and will be submitted in a separate Public Level Crossing Treatment Report (Phase 2).

As nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Document under condition E88. This approval is limited to the Phase 1 Public Level Crossing Treatment Report and applies only to the Phase 1 crossings at Ironbong Road (PU8160), Corby's Lane (PU33780) and Paper Road (PU11390). The Phase 1 Public Level Crossing Treatment Report approval does not apply to the Phase 2 crossings at Old Sydney Road (PU5600) or Unnamed Council Road (PU15950), which are to be addressed in a separate Phase 2 Public Level Crossing Treatment Report. The Phase 2 Public Level Crossing Treatment Report must be approved by the Planning Secretary prior to the establishment of the level crossings contained within it.
