1. Introduction

1.1 Background

1.1.1 Inland Rail and the proposal

The Australian Government has committed to delivering a significant piece of national transport infrastructure by constructing a high performance and direct interstate freight rail corridor between Melbourne and Brisbane, via central-west New South Wales (NSW) and Toowoomba in Queensland. Inland Rail is a major national program that will enhance Australia's existing national rail network and serve the interstate freight market.

The Inland Rail route, which is about 1,700 kilometres long, involves:

- using the existing interstate rail line through Victoria and southern NSW
- upgrading about 400 kilometres of existing track, mainly in western NSW
- providing about 600 kilometres of new track in NSW and south-east Queensland.

The Inland Rail program has been divided into 13 sections, seven of which are located in NSW. Each of these projects can be delivered and operated independently with tie-in points on the existing railway.

Australian Rail Track Corporation Ltd (ARTC) ('the proponent') is seeking approval to construct and operate the Narromine to Narrabri section of Inland Rail ('the proposal').

The proposal consists of about 306 kilometres of new single-track standard gauge railway with crossing loops. The proposal also includes changes to some roads to facilitate construction and operation of the new section of railway, and ancillary infrastructure to support the proposal.

The proposal would be constructed to accommodate double-stacked freight trains up to 1,800 metres long and 6.5 metres high. It would include infrastructure to accommodate possible future augmentation and upgrades of the track, including a possible future requirement for 3,600 metre long trains.

The land requirements for the proposal would include a new rail corridor with a minimum width of 40 metres, with some variation to accommodate particular infrastructure and to cater for local topography. The corridor would be of sufficient width to accommodate the infrastructure currently proposed for construction, as well as possible future expansion of crossing loops for 3,600 metre long trains. Clearing of the proposal site would occur to allow for construction and to maintain the safe operation of the railway.

1.1.2 Approval and assessment requirements

The proposal is critical State significant infrastructure and is subject to approval by the NSW Minister for Planning and Public Spaces under the NSW *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act). The proposal is also determined to be a controlled action under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity and Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) and requires approval from the Australian Minister for the Environment.

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was prepared to support ARTC's application for approval of the proposal in accordance with the requirements of Division 5.2 of the EP&A Act. The EIS addressed the environmental assessment requirements of the Secretary of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) ('the SEARs'), dated 9 September 2020.

The EIS was placed on public exhibition by DPIE for a period of 62 days, commencing on 8 December 2020, and concluding on 7 February 2021.

The EIS was also prepared to support ARTC's application for approval of the proposal under the EPBC Act.

The EIS was supported by a range of technical reports, which provide detailed assessments of the potential impacts of the proposal as they relate to the key environmental issues defined by the SEARs. This included *Technical Report 6 – Aboriginal cultural heritage* (JacobsGHD, 2020b).

1.1.3 Reporting to submissions and proposed amendments

During the exhibition period, interested stakeholders and members of the community were able to review the EIS online or at display locations, participate in consultation and engagement activities, and make a written submission to DPIE for consideration in its assessment of the proposal.

ARTC has prepared a Response to Submissions report to respond to submissions received during the exhibition period.

During and following public exhibition of the EIS, ARTC has undertaken further investigations and is proposing a number of design amendments to the proposal. The aim of these amendments is to address issues raised during consultation and in submissions, and to minimise the potential impacts of the proposal where practicable, particularly in respect of land use and property, flooding, traffic and access.

A summary of the proposed amendments is provided in Table 1.1. Further information is provided in the combined *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Preferred Infrastructure / Amendment Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021a).

1.2 The proposal

1.2.1 Location

The proposal would be located between the towns of Narromine and Narrabri in NSW. The proposal would link the Parkes to Narromine section of Inland Rail located in central west NSW, with the Narrabri to North Star section of Inland Rail located in north west NSW.

The location of the proposal is shown in Figure 1.1.

1.2.2 Key features

The key design features of the proposal (as amended) include:

Rail infrastructure

- a new 306 kilometre long rail corridor between Narromine and Narrabri
- a single-track standard gauge railway and track formation within the new rail corridor
- seven crossing loops, at Burroway, Balladoran, Armatree/Tonderburine, Mt Tenandra, Baradine, The Pilliga and Bohena Creek
- bridges over rivers and other watercourses (including the Macquarie River,
 Castlereagh River and the Namoi River/Narrabri Creek system), floodplains and roads
- level crossings
- new rail connections and possible future connections with existing ARTC and Country Regional Network rail lines, including a new 1.2 kilometre long rail junction between the Parkes to Narromine section of Inland Rail and the existing Narromine to Cobar Line (the Narromine West connection)


Road infrastructure

- road realignments at various locations, including realignment of the Pilliga Forest Way for a distance of 6.7 kilometres
- limited road closures.





Figure 1.2 Key features of the proposal (map 1)

The key features of the proposal are shown in Figure 1.2.

Ancillary infrastructure to support the proposal would include signalling and communications, drainage, drainage control areas, signage and fencing, and services and utilities.

Further information on the proposal is provided in the combined the combined *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Preferred Infrastructure / Amendment Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021a).

1.2.3 Construction overview

An indicative construction strategy has been developed based on the current reference design to be used as a basis for the environmental assessment process. Detailed construction planning, including programming, work methodologies, staging and work sequencing would be undertaken once construction contractor(s) have been engaged and during detailed design.

Timing and work phases

Construction of the proposal would involve five main phases of work as outlined in Table 1.2. It is anticipated that the first phase would commence in late 2022, and is expected to take about four years to complete.

Key construction infrastructure

The following key infrastructure is proposed to support construction of the proposal (as amended) (see

- borrow pits:
 - borrow pit A Tantitha Road, Narromine
 - borrow pit B Tomingley Road, Narromine
 - borrow pit C Euromedah Road, Narromine
 - borrow pit D Perimeter Road, Narrabri
- three main compounds, which would include a range of facilities to support construction ('multi-function compounds'), located at:
 - Narromine South
 - Curban
 - Narrabri West
- temporary workforce accommodation for the construction workforce:
 - within the Narromine South multi-function compound
 - Narromine North

- Gilgandra
- Baradine
- within the Narrabri West multi-function compound.

Other construction infrastructure would include a number of smaller compounds of various sizes located along the proposal site, concrete batching plants, laydown areas, welding yards and a concrete pre-cast facility.

Further information on the indicative construction methodology and the infrastructure required to support construction is provided in the combined *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Preferred Infrastructure / Amendment Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021a).

1.2.4 Operation

The proposal would form part of the rail network managed and maintained by ARTC. Train services would be provided by a variety of operators. The proposal is expected to be operational in 2026. Inland Rail as a whole would be operational once all 13 sections are complete, which is estimated to be in 2027.

It is estimated that the proposal would be trafficked by an average of 10 trains per day (both directions) in 2026, increasing to about 14 trains per day (both directions) in 2040. This rail traffic would be in addition to the existing rail traffic using other lines that the proposal interacts with.

The trains for Inland Rail as a whole would be a mix of grain, bulk freight, and other general transport trains. Total annual freight tonnages would be about 10 million tonnes in 2027, increasing to about 17.5 million tonnes in 2040.

Train speeds would vary according to axle loads, and range from 80 to 115 kilometres per hour.

1.3 Purpose and scope of this report

This Addendum ACHAR was prepared following the exhibition of the EIS to identify gaps associated with the project amendments and to inform the combined *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Preferred Infrastructure / Amendment Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021a). This document should be read in conjunction with *Technical Report 6 – Aboriginal cultural heritage* (JacobsGHD, 2020b). Background information, details of previously completed archaeological investigations, and other site information are not repeated in this report.

This Addendum ACHAR has been prepared with reference to the Secretary's environmental assessment requirements (SEARs), the *Guide to investigating, assessing and reporting on Aboriginal cultural heritage in NSW* (OEH, 2011) and *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2010* (DECCW, 2010a).

As part of the submissions process, a *Response to Submissions Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021b) has been prepared, which includes amended mitigation measures which supersede the measures presented in the EIS. The amended/additional mitigation measures proposed in this Addendum ACHAR (refer to section 5) will be documented in the *Response to Submissions Report*.

This report:

- provides an updated assessment of the proposal (as amended)
- addresses the relevant SEARs listed in Table 1.3
- provides additional information as required to respond to issues raised in submissions and during consultation
- recommends feasible and reasonable measures to mitigate the impacts identified.

The methodology for the assessment is described in section 2.




Figure 1.3 **Key construction infrastructure (map 1)**



2. Methodology and assessment scope

2.1 Context

In 2020, the *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report* (ACHAR) (JacobsGHD, 2020b) was prepared to support the EIS and assess the potential impacts of the proposal to identified Aboriginal objects and places.

Investigations to support the preparation of the ACHAR included desktop assessment, including all relevant database searches, the development of a predictive model to identify areas that were likely to be of cultural sensitivity and targeted field surveys in the company of the registered Aboriginal parties. The predictive model was developed using aerial imagery, the results of desktop assessment and literature review, results of the initial site survey, spatial datasets (including watercourses and contour mapping to identify important landforms), and information form the Heritage NSW Aboriginal Site Decision Support Tool (ASDST) and the Aboriginal Heritage Information Management System (AHIMS).

The ACHAR was prepared following the guidelines set out in the *Code of Practice for Archaeological Investigation of Aboriginal Objects in* NSW (Code of Practice) (DECCW, 2010a), the *Guide to Investigating, Assessing and Reporting on Aboriginal Cultural Heritage in* NSW (OEH, 2011), and the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2010* (DECCW, 2010c).

2.2 Legislative framework

The assessment of the amended proposal was guided by the principles of the:

- EP&A Act, the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 (NSW), the EPBC Act, the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Heritage Protection Act 1984 (Cth), the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) and the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (Cth)
- Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2010 (DECCW, 2010a)
- Code of Practice for Archaeological Investigation of Aboriginal Objects in NSW (DECCW, 2010b)
- Guide to investigating, assessing and reporting on Aboriginal cultural heritage in NSW (OEH, 2011).

2.3 Methodology

The methodology utilised in the preparation of *Technical Report 6 – Aboriginal cultural heritage* is outlined in Section 3 of that report.

The methodology adopted for this Addendum ACHAR generally followed requirements of the Code of Practice for Archaeological Investigation of Aboriginal Objects in NSW (Code of Practice) (DECCW, 2010b) and the Guide to investigating, assessing and reporting on Aboriginal cultural heritage in NSW (OEH, 2011).

The amended construction and operational footprints were assessed in GIS against the known AHIMS sites, areas of archaeological sensitivity and other important topological features such as waterways. Where there was a change compared to the impact assessed in the 2020 ACHAR, a revised impact assessment was prepared.

Additional mitigation measures were added to those presented in the 2020 ACHAR where necessary.

The draft Addendum ACHAR will be provided to the registered Aboriginal parties (RAPs) for the proposal for consultation in accordance with the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2010* (DECCW, 2010a).

Any responses and feedback provided by the RAPs will be included in the final Addendum ACHAR and in the combined *Inland Rail Narromine to Narrabri Preferred Infrastructure / Amendment Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021a).

2.4 Limitations and exclusions

The scope of this addendum report is based on information supplied by the proponent and existing, publicly available environmental and archaeological information. No independent verification of the results or interpretations of externally sourced reports was completed, except where archaeological investigation indicated inconsistencies. The Aboriginal Heritage Information Management System (AHIMS) data was provided by Heritage NSW and information in this report reflects the scope and the accuracy of the supplied AHIMS data. This report is limited to an assessment of Aboriginal objects and places in accordance with the Code of Practice.

2.5 Report authorship and acknowledgements

This report was prepared by Ryan Taddeucci (BA – Honours Archaeology), Masters of Museum Studies) (Senior Archaeologist, Jacobs), with technical review and management input from Fran Scully (Principal Archaeologist, Jacobs). Ryan has 10 years' experience working in Aboriginal and historical archaeology and cultural heritage management in Queensland, New South Wales and Western Australia. He has experience preparing preliminary advice reports, statements of heritage significance, statements of heritage impacts, heritage management plans, due diligence assessments, cultural heritage assessment reports, and technical reports for a range of archaeological and cultural heritage projects.

Fran holds a Master of Science in archaeological geophysics from the University of Bradford and has over 29 years' experience as a field archaeologist, consultant archaeologist, cultural heritage advisor, heritage regulator and policy advisor.

Mapping was prepared by Alison Jackson.

3. Aboriginal community consultation

In accordance with the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents* 2010 (DECCW, 2010a), a draft copy of this report was provided to the Native Title (NT) groups, local Aboriginal land councils (LALCs) and registered Aboriginal parties (RAPs) for review and comment. A review period of 28 days was provided.

Initially it was intended to conduct two Aboriginal focus groups (AFGs) in mid-January to provide a forum to discuss the proposal impacts and proposed mitigation measures. However due to concerns regarding COVID-19, it was decided that face to face meetings were not advisable at this time for health and safety reasons.

At the conclusion of the 28 day review period, all RAPs who had not provided comments were contacted via telephone (where phone numbers were provided) to provide an opportunity to discuss the proposal impacts and proposed mitigation recommendations documented in this report. A further follow up was made on 4 February 2022. Prior to finalising the report, an additional opportunity to provide comment was offered to RAPs who had not previously provided comment, between 26 May and 10 June. No further comments were received during this period. Comments made on the draft Addendum ACHAR during the review by the NT groups, LALCs and RAPs are summarised in Table 3.1. Comments have been edited for clarity.

3.1 Ongoing consultation

ARTC will continue to engage with stakeholders and the community in the lead up to, and during, construction.

Consultation with Heritage NSW, NT groups, LALCs and RAPs will extend past the investigation phase (as documented in this report). Further field surveys and archaeological investigations will follow the EIS approval and into the next phases of the proposal as detailed in section 10 of the EIS.

4. Revised impact assessment

The amended construction and operation footprints are shown on the maps in Appendix B. The amended footprint has resulted in a change in impact on the registered location of four AHIMS sites:

- Modified tree Boothaguy Creek ST6 (AHIMS ID 27-6-0042) (Appendix B: Figure 1.6)
- Modified tree Berida Road ST1 (AHIMS ID 28-4-0283) (Appendix B: Figure 1.8)
- Artefact scatter Calga Creek AFT and PAD (AHIMS ID 28-1-0059) (Appendix B: Figure 1.14)
- Artefact scatter NB-AS-04 (AHIMS ID 28-1-0095) (Appendix B: Figure 1.14).

The ACHAR assessed that the original proposal would pose a direct impact to Calga Creek AFT and PAD (AHIMS ID 28-1-0059) and NB-AS-04 (AHIMS ID 28-1-0095) resulting harm to the entire extent of both sites. However, based on the current proposed amended footprints, only a portion of both sites would be impacted by the amended proposal. As a result, these two sites would be partially impacted, resulting in a partial loss of value.

The ACHAR assessed that Berida Road ST1 (AHIMS ID 28-4-0283) would be indirectly impacted by the proposed works resulting in a potential loss of value. The amended proposal area would now extend to include the location of the Berida Road ST1 (AHIMS ID 28-4-0283). The modified tree would remain in situ, with the drainage control works placed to protect the tree. Further design work would be undertaken in detailed design to refine the proposed drainage controls, and every attempt would be made to reduce the ground disturbance works at this location. As a result, Berida Road ST1 (AHIMS ID 28-4-0283) is unlikely to the impacted by the amendment and there will be no loss of value.

As Boothaguy Creek ST6 (AHIMS ID 27-6-0042) was located outside the study area utilised for the ACHAR, impacts to the site were not assessed. The amended proposal area would now include Boothaguy Creek ST6 (AHIMS ID 27-6-0042). As the modified tree would remain in situ and further work would be done during detailed design to reduce the ground disturbance works at this location. As a result, Boothaguy Creek ST6 (AHIMS ID 27-6-0042) is unlikely to the impacted by the amendment and there will be no loss of value.

5. Recommended mitigation measures

The mitigation measures presented in Table 10.1 and Table 10.2 of the ACHAR have been superseded by the amended mitigation measures that are documented in the *Response to Submissions Report* (JacobsGHD, 2021b). They remain similar in content and intent, however have been revised to provide additional clarity. The revised measures are provided in Table 5.1.

NB-AS-04 (AHIMS ID 28-1-0095), an artefact scatter, was assessed in the ACHAR as being of low significance. As a result, NB-AS-04 (AHIMS ID 28-1-0095) would be subject to mitigation measure AH8 (impacts on artefact scatters). Surface collection (salvage) of artefact scatters located within the portion of NB-AS-04 (AHIMS ID 28-1-0095) would occur prior to construction. No artefacts located outside the impact area should be salvaged, they should remain in-situ.

Calga Creek AFT and PAD (AHIMS ID 28-1-0059) is an artefact scatter and associated PAD. As a result it would be subject to mitigation measure AH5 (Impacts on PADs) and AH8 (impacts on artefact scatters). Surface collection (salvage) of the artefact scatter located within the portion of Calga Creek AFT and PAD (AHIMS ID 28-1-0059) would occur prior to construction. No artefacts located outside the impact area should be salvaged, they should remain in-situ. Sub-surface archaeological test excavations would be undertaken to confirm the nature and extent of any subsurface artefacts. If test excavation confirms the presence of subsurface artefacts, the site would be managed in consultation with Heritage NSW and the RAPs. If salvage excavations are required, it would be managed in accordance with the salvage methodology (mitigation measure AH2).

Boothaguy Creek ST6 (AHIMS ID 27-6-0042) and Berida Road ST1 (AHIMS ID 28-4-0283) are modified trees which are unlikely to be impacted by the amended proposal. However there would be an opportunity to potentially reduce the direct footprint of the proposal at these locations, affording additional protection against inadvertent damage, so it is of value to include additional mitigation measures for these two locations. Where impact is unavoidable due to design change, the sites would be subject to mitigation measure AH6 (Direct impacts on modified trees).
