I hereby submit my objection to the development of the proposed Hardrock Quarry Project, which, if approved, will impact the local community in a number of ways.

The projected number of truck cycles along the haulage route, 6 days a week, will affect road integrity, especially if substantial rain falls, which will undermine the road structure.

Elderslie Bridge is single-lane with traffic management having a give-way for northbound movements; in addition, no passing. These measures have invoked some stand-off situations between cars during peak hour. Overlaying the truck movements, this would promote more congestion and angry drivers.

I am concerned that this development will have an impact on the diverse flora and fauna in the area and the potential for byproducts to enter the water system.

Residents adjacent to the haulage route would suffer immense noise pollution from the climbing and braking trucks.

I do indeed reside in a tranquil part of the Hunter Valley and hope this is not intruded upon by this development.
