Concerns of Community Members Around Thunderbolt Wind Farm Stage 1

LANDSCAPE, VISUAL, SHADOW FLICKER

- Turbines will be 270m+ tall
- Think Centrepoint Tower in Sydney
- New England landscape irreversibly changed
- Shadow flicker will affect morning & afternoon light in your home
- Sleep disturbance for residents at Balala, Kentucky, Green Valley, Wollun
- Impacts on those with pre-existing conditions
- Impacts on mental health



NOISE & VIBRATION

- 55 km new 9m wide gravel roads on Kyabra
- Blasting to create turbine foundations
- Noise & dust from construction & traffic over several years
- INFRASOUND travels hundreds of km
- Insufficient science on impacts of constant infrasound on human & livestock health
- Neoen is not interested in community concerns - very poor community consultation

WIND COMPANY **SUFFERS** HEARING **LOSS**

WILDLIFE & HABITAT

- Prior to felling, Neoen will be "shaking habitat trees with heavy machinery (as appropriate) to encourage fauna to abandon trees".
- COMPARE THIS TO LIVESTOCK HEALTH AND WELFARE RULES FOR FARMERS!
- Endangered species on site: Koala, Spotted Tailed Quoll, Tiger Quoll, White Throated Needletail, Squirrel Glider, Boorolong Frog, Bush Stone Curlew, Scarlett Robyn +++
- White Box Yellow Box Blakely's Red Gum Grassy Woodland is "Critically Endangered" (Federal Govt EPBC Act 1999). Offsets wont bring it back.

WANTED: DOZER DRIVER TO 'SHAKE **WILDLIFE FROM** TREES'

CUMULATIVE IMPACTS

- 590+ turbines planned in 70 km radius of Walcha
- Cumulative impacts on everyone who lives, visits, works and drives through New England:
 - Visual amenity, noise, traffic congestion, road disrepair & erosion, wildlife habitat destruction, loss of cultural heritage, reduced water quality and quantity, loss of TV and mobile reception.
- At least 1000m³ concrete (3,000t) each footing = 100,000t for this proposal alone, or 1.77Mt for the region – never to be removed.
- If 55 km for 32 turbines, will it be 900 km for 590 turbines?
- LGAs supply the water, gravel & other resources
- No solid decommissioning or recycling plans
- Who foots the bill for the long term mess?
- IRONY turbine technology already superseded!

WANTED: LARGE LANDFILL SITE FOR OLD **GROWTH TURBINES**

LACK OF STATE PLANNING

- Because Renewable Energy Zones declared with no landscape scale landuse planning, we have:
 - 1. Arbitrary choice made by Macquarie St
 - 2. No sound selection criteria
 - 3. Foreign corporates put in charge deciding where large scale installations go
- Lack of consultation with community has led to community division
- We implore our Councillors to press the State
 Govt for proper planning involving hosts,
 neighbours of hosts, and the broader
 community and insist on a moratorium on large
 scale energy developments until this plan exists.

SHORT TERM GAIN. LONG **TERM** PAIN.

BETTER ALTERNATIVES

- Large scale wind installations are NOT the most efficient renewables – small to medium scale are better options (Prof Alistair Sprout, UNSW School of Photovoltaic and Renewable Energy Engineering)
- Foreign owned large scale wind installations send profits overseas
- Community led *Embedded Microgrids* are most efficient and profit regional Australia
- ARENA \$50M in grants under Regional Australia Microgrids Program for pilots that reduce barriers
 & assist development (Leon Chanter, Australian Renewable Energy Agency)
- Lightbulb moment?
 Let's get it right at the appropriate level and in the appropriate places, before it's too late.
