
TfNSW key interests are the safety and efficiency of the transport network, the needs of our customers and the integration of land use and transport in accordance with Future Transport Strategy 2056.

Owen Street is a public (local) road under the *Roads Act 1993* (Roads Act). Port Macquarie Hastings Council (PMHC) is the Roads Authority for this road. Council is responsible for setting standards and determining priorities. In accordance with Section 138 of the *Roads Act 1993*, Council's approval is required prior to works being undertaken on this road. TfNSW concurrence is not required for unclassified roads.

TfNSW appreciates the opportunity to comment on the proposed modification. No further comments are provided in respect to the subject development and the previous advice issued on 28 September 2021 in respect to the School Travel Plan remains relevant.
