Dear Michael,

Please urgently advise your client that this sort of email is not conducive to this matter being resolved via the arbitration process.

Access to Warwick station has been traditionally via Nulla road, we have spoken to the Dept of Planning & Environment and are currently engaged with them regarding the Legal Road Network (LRN) project. We understand that this project has the aim of formalising traditional access via a consultative and interactive process whereby your client as owner of Huntingfield will be involved.

If your client wishes RZ to cease access to the property it has leased and is purchasing via its traditional access then please seek an injunction to attempt to stop such access.

With regard to the soil sampling on Nulla Road, your client knows and has been advised by council that RZ has sought and received permission to do so. Your client was also told by the council when he complained that Nulla road was not his

private road and that 30 metres on either side of the centre line was a public road.

This is just silly .

Please confirm by return that RZ does not have to worry about these unproductive threats .

We repeat that RZ resources and contractors do not have permission to access Warwick station through Huntingfield/Sunshine station. There is no easement for you to travel through our property for the purpose of accessing Warwick Station. RZ Resources needs to cease travelling through our paddock immediately. RZ resources have no access to Huntingfield/Sunshine, for any purpose, until we resolve matters through arbitration.

Please stop using the road through Huntingfield/Sunshine to access Warwick. We reserve the right to permanently close that boundary gate, without further notice to you, if the access does not immediately cease.

Regarding soil sampling, RZ resources do not have our consent/permission to conduct any mining activities on Huntingfield/Sunshine station, including soil sampling, beside the road or in any other place.

Please advise what you mean by SSM?
