I write in strong support of the Rix's Creek North Modification 10 PA 08\_0102.

Approval of the Rix's Creek North Modification 10 will provide the following benefits:

- 1. The upgrade of CHPP facilities by installation of new processing equipment including solid bowl centrifuges which will reduce the future reliance on tailings dams.
- 2. New Run of Mine (ROM) coal stockpiles on existing disturbed areas which will allow greater flexibility and reduce the need for double handling.
- 3. An extension to the workshop to facilitate easier maintenance of equipment.
- 4. The use of an in-pit rock crushing facility to utilise rock materials onsite assisting to reducing the need to import materials for road construction and or stemming for blasting.
- 5. The replacement of an existing substation and the installation of a new switching station.
- 6. The disposal of heavy vehicle waste tyres, (which is already approved under the Environmental Protection Licence for the Rix's Creek South Mine) and disposal of inert waste concrete materials in-pit.
