Jemena Eastern Gas Pipeline (collectively Jemena) has reviewed and assessed the planning proposal referenced above. Jemena has given consideration to the potential safety and impacts on and from the Eastern Gas Pipeline Gas Pipelines located to the east of the proposed development.

Jemena objects to the development on the following grounds:

 Jemena objects to the proposed planning application. Subject to the following Conditions: An Encroachment Safety Management Study on the Design and Construction as per AS2885.6 must be conducted to identify all threats posed by construction and ongoing existence of the development with regard to the Eastern Gas Pipeline in this location. All actions arising from this SMS must be addressed and closed. Jemena must provide acceptance of the sign-off report prior to commencement of the development;

It is noted that a SMS would be required to be undertaken by an appropriately qualified professional and Jemena are to be a party to any such study. Any costs associated with convening a SMS will be borne by the applicant/proponent, along with any additional protection measures or mitigation works that will need to be implemented by Jemena or the proponent as required by the findings of the SMS.

To provide some greater context to the decision above, the transmission pipeline operates at pressures greater than 6MPa and is located within easements secured under the provisions of the *Pipelines Act 1967* and the *Conveyancing Act 1919 (NSW)*. As owner and manager of the pipeline, Jemena has rights and obligations under its pipeline licence, the *Pipelines Act 1967* (NSW) and Australian Standard 2885 that relate to ensuring the ongoing safety and integrity of its pipelines. It takes its rights and obligations under these instruments seriously.
