

QUARRY SUBMISSION

- There has been no communication about heavy truck movements on Winfarthing Rd.
- There has been very little communication from GQ at all.
- I have lived on Winfarthing Road for 41 years after growing up in Sydney and Wollongong.
- I had never lived in a rural area before and don't intend to be pushed out by this development.
- I would not be able to stay due to health issues I have that would be compromised by such a business.
- Rural living is the best place for myself and many other residents who have health issues.
- I have raised 3 children and they and their families love to come home to spend in this peaceful and tranquil setting.
- We have a large dam on our property that we use as water supply for our home and it is also used for swimming when the family comes home. It is also home to Yabbies, fish and many varieties of birds frequent it.

REASONS WHY THE QUARRY SHOULD NOT GO AHEAD

- Silica Dust from so called CLEAN FILL that is being brought in will land on our roofs and end up in our WATER TANKS and vegetable gardens. Making our water and food impossible to consume due to CONTAMINATION.
- Air pollution from dust and fumes from the trucks and machinery used at the quarry.
- Noise pollution from trucks, machinery and blasting.
- Damage to Winfarthing Road from heavy truck movements.
- Concerns that if there is a MISFIRE during blasting our road will be closed for extended periods putting everyone here at risk. If there is a bushfire at that time our road has no alternate exit path. Also with many older residents and others with medical conditions Ambulance, Police and Fire Fighters would not be able to gain access to assist us which could be fatal.
- Concerns for the safety of our young residents who catch the school bus to Goulburn (NOT MARULAN as assumed by the quarry people) as they can only be picked up by the bus from the intersection of the highway. There is no area for the bus to turn around on our road as the quarry people suggested as an alternative to the highway pickup.
- History show that with development such as this our land values will decrease dramatically and will not be able to be sold.
- Damage to our homes and outbuildings from the blasting.
- Death and destruction of the local Fauna and Flora.

- There is no constant water supply to the area for them to deal with air pollution.
- There are also Aboriginal artefacts on this site and Heritage Listed buildings as well.
- Common sense and decency should prevail but some businesses don't really have care how we feel!
