To Whom It May Concern,

I, George Emerzidis, a resident of Winfarthing Road, Marulan, formally object to the application (SSD-65146459) submitted by Global Quarries Australia Pty Ltd to the NSW State Government to operate a quarry in our Rural Residential Environmental E3 Zone area. My objections are outlined below:

A) Lack of Consultation:

Global Quarries Australia Pty Ltd has failed to consult with local residents over the past five years regarding their proposal and its potential impact on the community, wildlife, and biodiversity.

B) Insufficient Information on Blasting:

There is a lack of information provided about the frequency and impact of regular blasting on residents and wildlife.

C) Health Risks from Silica Dust:

Silica dust, which could be released from the quarry, poses a significant health risk as it can travel to our water tanks and cause cancer in both humans and animals

D) Increased Traffic and Safety Concerns:

The operation would result in a high volume of quarry trucks entering and exiting Winfarthing Road, raising concerns about traffic safety and increased wear and tear on local infrastructure.

E) Impact on School Bus Stop:

The increased truck traffic would also impact the safety of children at the school bus stop located at the corner of Winfarthing Road and the Hume Highway.

Based on these concerns, I strongly reject the application by Global Quarries Australia Pty Ltd. My experiences with the company indicate they are not trustworthy, as they have previously demonstrated a lack of consultation and transparency, frequently altering plans outlined in their Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) without proper communication.
