As a leading mining services business, Schlam Payload is pleased to offer this submission in support of the Maules Creek Continuation Project proposed by Whitehaven Coal.

The proposed extension of the mine life by 10 years can be expected to have significant flow on economic benefits for all companies within the Maules Creek value chain.
