## Objection to SSD Metropolitan Modification 4 Longwall 317 and 318 Modification by J & C Riggall – 26 August 2025

We became most concerned after we discovered this application when reading an Agenda item in Wollongong Council's meeting yesterday 25 August 2025, item 19 Notice of Motion by Councillor Stuart (copy attached).
