Integrity Pumps and Engineering welcomes the opportunity to provide this submission in support of the Ulan West Continued Operations Modification Report.

As a proud supplier to the Ulan Complex, we recognise the significant contribution Ulan West makes to the local economy, regional employment, and the broader New South Wales community. The continuation of operations at the site will provide long-term certainty for local businesses like ours and sustain vital economic activity across the region.

It is important to note that this modification **does not propose a new mine, does not increase the scale or intensity of existing operations**, and will result in **no additional or new environmental impacts**. The proposal simply allows Ulan West to continue operating within its existing, well-managed footprint under the same high environmental standards that have been consistently demonstrated over time.

Approval of this modification will allow Ulan West to:

- Provide ongoing, stable employment to its workforce;
- Continue supporting local businesses and suppliers — with the Ulan Complex spending around **\$470 million annually** with more than **920 suppliers**, many of them local;
- Maintain payment of taxes, royalties and other government contributions that fund essential public services such as infrastructure, education, health and policing; and
- Continue supporting local charities, community organisations and sporting clubs, as well as major community initiatives such as the *Mudgee 4 Doctors* program, *Country Universities Centre in Mudgee*, and the *Mudgee High School LINK Program*.

The Ulan West Mine has demonstrated a strong record of safe, responsible and environmentally sustainable operations. The proposed continuation will ensure that these economic and community benefits remain in place for years to come, without creating additional environmental impacts or changes to the mine's scale or footprint.

For Integrity Pumps and Engineering, and many other regional suppliers, this project represents critical business continuity and ongoing opportunities to contribute to local industry and employment.

We therefore fully support the approval of the Ulan West Continued Operations Modification.
