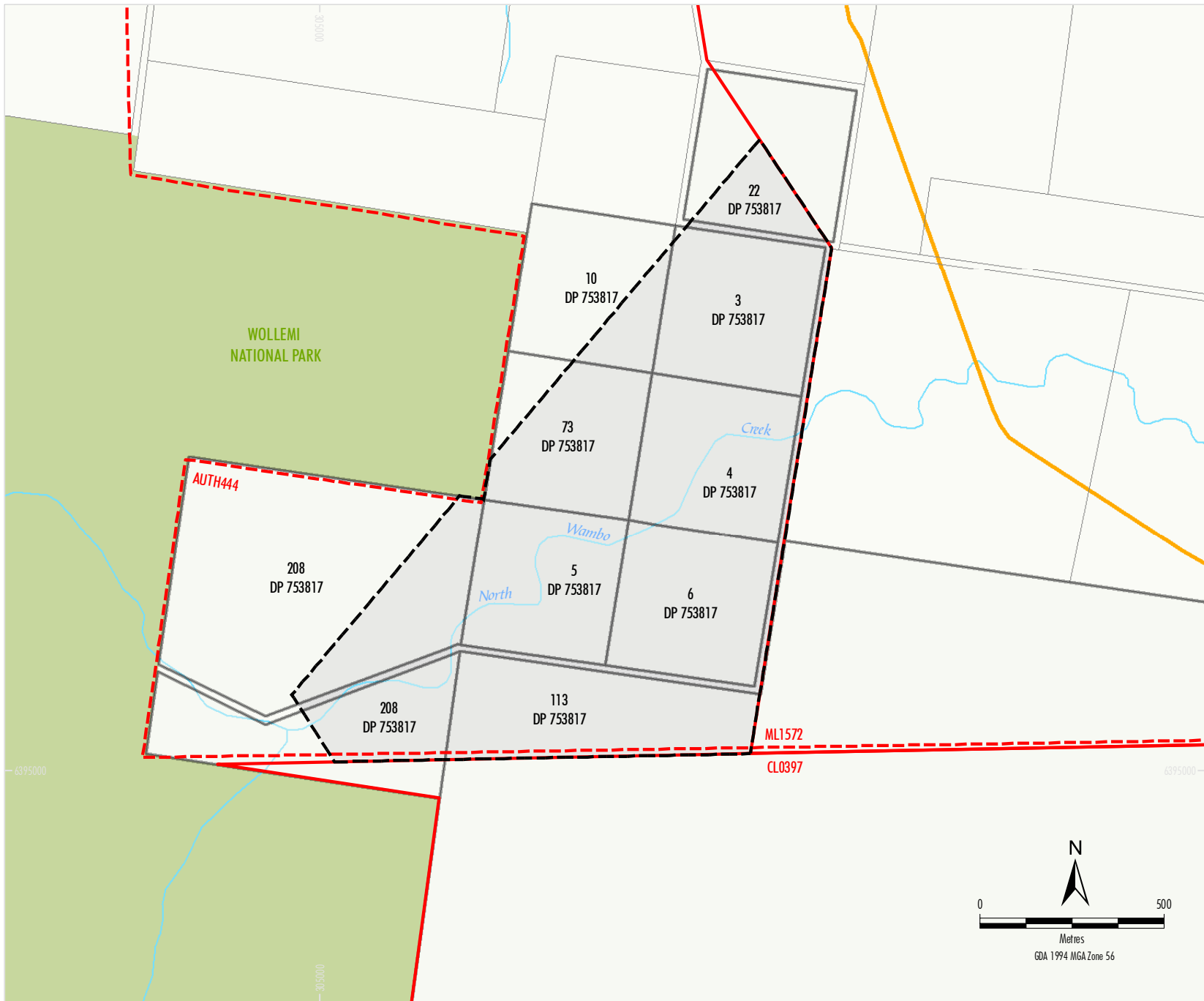

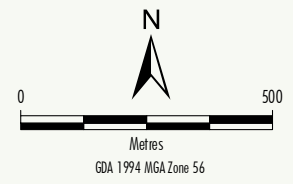
The SVC Application Area is shown on the enclosed plan.
