Re: Request for SEARs (DA 14/96 MOD 11) upgrade of concrete batching plant (CBP) and quarry materials handling facility, St Peters, NSW.

I refer to your email received by the Heritage Division, Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH), on 11 October 2016, seeking the Heritage Council of NSW input into the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for a State Significant Development at Burrows Road, South, St Peters.

It is understood that the request relates to a modification involving:

• Increase production of the existing concrete batching plant (CBP) on site.

It is noted that the Alexandra Canal is the closest State Heritage Register listed item (SHR# 01621) in relation to the subject land. The Heritage Division recommends the inclusion of a SEAR which requires the proponent undertake a statement of heritage impact as part of the Environmental Assessment which considers any impact the proposal might have on the Alexandra Canal and any other heritage items within the vicinity.

The SOHI should be prepared by a suitably qualified and experienced heritage consultant and determine whether the increased production proposed and associated works are likely to impact any item of the environmental heritage in the vicinity of the subject site. If impact is likely appropriate mitigation measures should be identified commensurate with the significance of the heritage item.
