Hi Rob,

OEH notes the views of DPE that any indirect impacts on the biodiversity values of land adjacent to and east of the modified development area (ie within Lot 7308) were adequately assessed and approved via Modification 1 and that there are no new impacts resulting from Modification 2.

OEH's advice of 2 January 2019 was that Modification 2 could not be supported based on the rational provided in Umwelt's 28 November 2018 letter for amending the 40m buffer. OEH considered the adjoining land (lot 7308) was <u>most likely</u> 'community land' managed by The Hills Shire Council as bushland. This is incorrect as your advice is that the land is zoned RU1 – Primary Production and is not bushland set aside for conservation. Based on the information provided, OEH does not object to proposed Modification 2.

Hi Rob,

The assessment of indirect impacts for a major project in the Framework for Biodiversity Assessment (FBA) is addressed in section 8.4 (see pages 28-29 in <u>this link</u> to the FBA). As discussed this morning, Umwelt's argument at point 3 is that the EA has adequately assessed the potential indirect biodiversity impacts of the modification in accordance with the requirements of the FBA. The EA states *'the Modification is not expected to result in any substantial indirect impacts on the biodiversity values of the surrounding lands during the construction or operational phases of the Modification'* (s. 6.7.5.2, p. 97). While not stated in the EA, it is assumed the buffer width considered by the EA when assessing indirect impacts on the biodiversity values of the adjoining land east of the Haerses Road extension (lot 7308) is as shown in figure 1.3 of the EA (and figure 1.2 of the Biodiversity Assessment Report) - this is clearly at odds with the 40m buffer required by (appendix 2 of) the modification consent.


