Mandalong Southern Extension Project Modification 8 (SSD 5144 MOD 8)

I refer to your email dated 30 April 2019 inviting Subsidence Advisory to provide comment on the Mandalong Southern Extension Project Modification 8.

Subsidence Advisory understands the application involves;

- increasing the number of full-time equivalent personnel at the Mandalong Mine Access Site (MMAS)
- upgrading the MMAS's existing electrical substation; and
- clearing vegetation to facilitate upgrading of the substation and expansion of existing car parking facilities.

Under the *Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Act 2017*, construction of improvements within a Mine Subsidence District requires approval from Subsidence Advisory. If the upgrading of the substation and the expansion of the existing car park facilities involves the construction of surface improvements, approval from Subsidence Advisory should be sought.
