

CRUDINE RIDGE WIND FARM SUBMISSION

Dear Major Projects Team,

We have been following the plight of the residents affected by the Crudine Ridge Wind Farm development, both in the national and local media.

The project was referred to the Federal Department of Environment in April 2017, who reduced the number of turbines from 77 to 37 under ecological grounds. The developer now wishes to use more powerful turbines and longer blades. We understand they have now submitted a Modification Application to the NSW DPE. If approval is granted, this will necessitate even more roadside clearing to enable transportation of the larger turbine components. Given the history of this project, we feel this Modification Application must be referred to the Independent Planning Commission, especially taking into consideration the FDE's previous decision.
