EPA comment on Statement of Environment Effects**

I refer to your e-mail dated 6 December 2018 and request for the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) to provide comment on the Environmental Assessment (EA) prepared for the modification application submitted by Crudine Ridge Wind Farm Pty Limited for the above project.
