The department provides the following comments and recommendations for consideration in assessment of the proposal.

DoI — Water and Natural Resources Access Regulator

Recommendations prior to approval

- Further details should be provided of the water demands and potential sources of water for the proposed Aarons Pass Road upgrade.

Recommendations post approval

- All works on waterfront land, including the installation of new culverts, should be undertaken in accordance with the Guidelines for Controlled Activities on Waterfront Land (NRAR 2018).
- The proponent should prepare a Soil and Water Management Plan and Erosion and Sediment Control Plan as part of the CEMP in consultation with NRAR prior to the commencement of activities.

DoI Crown Lands

- DoI Crown Lands and the Crown Land Manager require 14 days notice before any construction takes place.
