You should be very well placed in your role as Minister for both Planning and Housing to review the redevelopment proposals for Greenwich Hospital. As a Greenwich resident, I am one of a growing number of residents with a concern about the proposal to build 89 residential units on the site of Greenwich Hospital to six storeys.

The lack of existing planning controls on the site creates the opportunity for the applicant to make this application for development outcomes not considered in the establishment of the hospital.

It's tenuous at best for the applicant to suggest that two, six storey apartment buildings for 'older people' are connected with the palliative care hospital - surely not everyone who has palliative care is old? Nor is it likely that everyone who is old will require palliative care.

This sets a very dangerous, multi-unit residential development precedent south of River Road and will undoubtedly give rise to further an increasing multi unit residential development efforts outside the corridors established on Pacific Highway Lane Cove.

You are uniquely placed to take a strong interest in this matter as our Local Member. I would urge you to seek either removal of these unit blocks from the development or significant de-scaling.
