

- * *Health Impacts*

- * *Contractual secrecy containing gag clauses*
- * *Destruction of flora and fauna*
- * *Devaluation of affected land and surrounding land*
- * *Safety issues relating to blade throw and fire dangers, and the inability to fight fires near turbines*
- * *Danger to low flying agricultural air craft*
- * *Shadow Flicker*
- * *Further damage to already dangerous country roads*
- * *Destruction of historic, heritage and cultural areas*
- * *Reduced agricultural productivity*
- * *Division of rural communities and alienation within families*
- * *Destruction of rural social infrastructure*
- * *Enforced tax payer subsidies to the wind turbine industry*
- * *Inefficient and intermittent electricity production*

- * *Inadequate or non-existent provision for decommissioning and removal of old turbines*
