
I, Thomas Green of "Fairfield" Wellington 2820, wish to lodge my objection to the proposal to construct up to 40 wind turbines in the Bodangora area approximately 20 klms from Wellington.

My objection to this proposal is on the basis of the following points:

1. Destruction of grassy box woodland, already severely restricted in this State, by the construction of large wind turbines.
2. Devaluation of property due to the visual and noise pollution of rural landscapes by structures unsympathetic to the countryside aesthetic.
3. Damage during the construction phase to already inadequate and dangerous country roads ,and the risk to residents using these roads

I therefore petition the Department of Planning & Infrastructure to disallow this proposal and anticipate your Departments favourable consideration of this submission.
