Environmental Assessment for Bodangora Wind Farm (MP10_0157)

Reference is made to a letter from Mr Toby Philp, Acting Manager, Energy Infrastructure Projects, dated 4 June 2012, inviting Crown Lands, Department of Primary Industries, to make a submission on the proposed Bodangora Wind Farm.

The Environmental Assessment (EA) has been reviewed and I can advise that Crown Lands has no comment on the proposed Wind Farm as the turbines will all be constructed on freehold lands. Crown Lands is satisfied that the mitigation measures as described in the EA will be appropriate to reduce impacts to an acceptable level and that any shortfalls will be noted during this review process.

It is noted that Infigen Energy intends to truck the turbine components to the various sites. From the information provided, the proposed truck route incorporates a number of internal property tracks and unformed Crown roads held by the adjoining landholders as Enclosure Permits.

Infigen Energy should be advised that, if the Bodangora Wind Farm development is approved, they will need to contact Crown Lands, Department of Primary Industries, to determine appropriate actions to enable their use of any Crown roads for the transportation of the turbine components.
