This submission is made on behalf of the Ryde Gladesville Climate Change Action Group. We are a community group of over 640 people concerned about climate change and wanting governments of all levels to take decisive and immediate action to reduce our carbon emissions by moving rapidly to renewable energy and phasing out of our reliance on fossil fuels.
