The stretch the road between the intersection of Lindsay Gap road/Nundle road and the beginning of the village itself creates a bottle neck, with one way in, one way out of the village. The clogging up of this section by the wind farm construction traffic will cause extensive disruption to **every road user, every business and every resident of the area.**

As a long time resident and now with significant health issues, this road is my life line to medical services and other facilities Tamworth has to offer.

I refuse to contemplate that we should have our lives turned up side down for the sake of this project.

The pollution is the concern too, not only the noise pollution, but the exhaust gases of trucks coming through this pinch point. I frequently walk this road, as at my age the only exercise I can withstand is a level walk either along the proposed transport route or the river walk.

The large proportion of Nundle's population are people of my generation, the retired folk, and they share similar concerns about the traffic impact on the village and the only road in and out.

I also feel heartbroken about the way we are as a community now. The division is stressful. You have to pick sides now in this village.
