**Notice of Exhibition – Qantas Flight Training Centre – 297 King Street, Mascot – SSD 10154**

I refer to email correspondence received on 3 June 2019 inviting the NSW Environment Protection Authority (“**EPA**”) to provide comment on the Environmental Impact Statement (“**EIS**”) for the development of the Qantas Flight Training Centre at 297 King Street, Mascot.

On the basis of information provided, the proposal does not constitute a Scheduled Activity under Schedule 1 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (“**the POEO Act**”). The EPA does not consider that the proposal will require an Environment Protection Licence (“**EPL**”) under the POEO Act. The EPA understands that the proposal is not being undertaken by or on behalf of a NSW public authority. The EPA is therefore not the appropriate regulatory authority for the proposal.

Accordingly, the EPA has no further comment regarding the proposal and has no further interest in this matter.
