NOTICE OF EXHIBITION FOR COLLECTOR WIND FARM (SSD 5175 MOD 2)

Reference is made to your correspondence received on 15 October 2017 notifying the Heritage Council of NSW of the exhibition of, and inviting comment on, the abovementioned modification of the State Significant Development application for the Collector Wind Farm.

It is noted that the Heritage Council of NSW do not appear to have been invited to provide comment on either the original proposal or MOD 1.

The subject site is not within the curtilage of any State Heritage Register (SHR) items or known historic archaeology. Consequently, no specific comments are provided as no impacts to SHR items or State or local archaeological remains have been identified. It is noted consent condition D25 requires a Construction Heritage Management Plan which should provide guidance in the event of unexpected archaeological finds.
