The Department has received an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Stubbo Solar Farm, located approximately 10 kilometres north of Gulgong, within the Mid-Western Regional Council Local Government area.

The proposal involves the construction, operation and decommissioning of a 400 megawatt solar photovoltaic plant, energy storage facility and associated infrastructure.
