As commented for the demolition phase, police expectations during construction are just the same...

- Notification of any road closures during demolition and construction work.
- Adequate lighting of the work site at night.
- The work site to be secured at night or during periods of inactivity.
- Security patrols of the work site by contracted licensed security guards.
- All engineers, workers, visitors, security guards, etc be vetted and to follow instructions and warnings as stipulated in a formal induction process.
- Police be offered a familiarisation tour of the work site.
- Notification of any suspicious activity or objects in or around the work site during demolition and construction work.
- A list of key contacts on the work site.

Modern developments incorporate CPTED principles to design out criminal opportunities and this development is no exception and, for this reason I would welcome an opportunity to view construction drawings (my background is electrical contracting in the construction industry).
