I refer to your correspondence dated 25 June 2019 seeking key issue and assessment requirements regarding bush fire protection for the above Part 3A/State Significant Development Application in accordance with section 75F (4) of the 'Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979'.

The New South Wales Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) has considered the information submitted and provides the following advice:

- 1. The provision of water, electricity and gas associated with the proposed works are to comply with sections 4.1.3 and 4.2.7 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
- 2. Emergency vehicle access should continue to be provided onto the sports fields from Mount Pleasant Avenue and/or Osborn Road
- 3. A Bush Fire Emergency Management and Evacuation Plan shall be prepared consistent with 'Development Planning- A Guide to Developing a Bush Fire Emergency Management and Evacuation Plan December 2014'.
- 4. Construction of the proposed Gonzaga Barry Centre Extension, and the Mount Pleasant Pavilion, shall comply with Sections 3 and 5 (BAL 12.5) Australian Standard AS3959-2009 'Construction of buildings in bush fire-prone areas' or NASH Standard (1.7.14 updated) 'National Standard Steel Framed Construction in Bushfire Areas – 2014' as appropriate and section A3.7 Addendum Appendix 3 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
- 5. Landscaping to the site is to comply with the principles of Appendix 5 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
