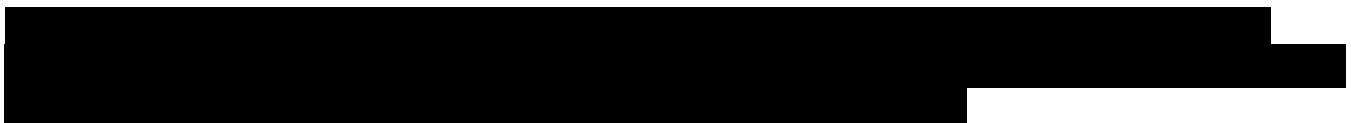
Hi Patrick
