I have looked at the amended proposal including the plans and wish to express why I support the amended proposal.

Mixed housing types

The area where the development is proposed has been zoned residential for almost 30 years.

There is a mixture or residential blocks, medium density blocks and for integrated housing.

I like this mix. There are not a great number of medium density blocks. I particularly like the integrated lots as it will give people the opportunity to downsize, own a property that is manageable but most importantly people will not need to move away from the area to downsize.

Integration with the township

The area proposed for medium density and integrated housing are within walking distance to shops and services. This will result in little if any increase in car parking at the shopping area.

Ecological sustainable development (ESD)

The proposal includes provisions that every lot has solar panels and rainwater tanks.

I understand also that there will be a higher than usual requirement based on BASIX, for energy efficiency targets with a requirement for 7 star natHERS ratings.

Employment.

There are many building trade persons, as well as people employed in building materials supply whom will benefit from the development.

An increase in population will benefit the local economy and shops in the area.
