Objection to the West Culburra Concept Proposal (SSD 3846 Culburra Beach NSW 2540)

Dear Sir/Madam,

While I support the decision to remove the Lake Wollumboola catchment from the development proposal, I would like to object to the West Culburra Concept Proposal for a number of safety, cultural heritage, environmental and commercial issues:

Safety

• Allowing up to 293 dwellings to be built in a location with "one road in and one road" out seems to ignore the lessons of the 2019-20 bushfires in the Shoalhaven.

Cultural heritage

• The development with access to the Crookhaven River shore would result in degradation of Aboriginal middens and Aboriginal cultural heritage.

Environmental

- The housing estate would require clearing of over 47 ha of Currambene Lowland Coastal Forest and so greatly impact a habitat corridor which extends west to the Shoalhaven escarpment and north to the Crookhaven River Wetlands.
- The removal of any habitat in unburned coastal forest, when so much of the South Coast forests were destroyed in the 2019-2020 fires, is of great concern to me.
- The development would take out habitat for a number of woodland fauna and flora species, some of which have threatened status, like the Powerful Owl and Glossy Black Cockatoo.
- The risk for flow-on impacts through increased populations could have indirect impacts on the wider Culburra Beach environment, including Lake Wollumboola's internationally significant birdlife.

Commerical

• Any impact on the Coastal Wetlands in Curleys Bay and along the Crookhaven River could cause water quality issues which could be devastating for the oyster and fishing industries.
